- Participants will receive a free box of produce for 12 weeks
- Participants will receive one-on-one support from a community health worker
- Participants will take part in one class per month about healthy eating and healthy cooking.
- We will help participants enroll in nutrition support programs and services (SNAP/WIC and/or Manna) and we will connect participants with community resources that promote healthy living such as walking clubs, yoga, zumba, etc.
